VIKING HAT



Be a Viking for Halloween! Step 1: Viking Hat



1. For sizing, find a cap that already fits and use that as a guide. Cut out 6 or 7 pieces of cardstock in the triangular shapes above and 2 horn pieces (old cereal boxes work great).



2. Glue the pieces together to form the shape of the hat using a hot glue gun. Cut a strip of cardstock to wrap and glue around the bottom. Cut a small cone shape to glue on top.



3. Glue the horn pieces into place on the sides of the hat.



4. Paint the hat to look like stone.

Be a Viking for Halloween! Step 2: Viking Face Paint (Purchase at your local Halloween or party shop)



HICCUP: RED

Paint 2 swipes of red face paint onto your cheek under each eye. Paint a V shape on your forehead.



FISHLEGS: GREEN & ORANGE

Paint a giant green U shape around your face, starting under your eyes. Outline with orange facepaint and make an orange triangle on your chin.



ERET: BROWN TATTOO

Paint a thick line from under your bottom lip to the bottom of your chin with brown face paint. Paint L shapes to the left and right of the line. Next to both L shapes make a thick line 1/3 the length of the first one.



SNOTLOUT: RED & YELLOW

Paint a swipe of red face paint onto your cheek under each eye. Paint a stripe on your chin and also your forehead. Paint a swipe of yellow under each red cheek stripe.



ASTRID: AQUA & ORANGE

Paint 2 C shapes around your eyes and a V shape on your forehead with orange face paint. Paint an orange triangle on your chin. Outline the orange shapes with aqua face paint.
